- U.S. citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- Household income low to moderate--please see back
- Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher
(if you do not meet this GPA requirement, please provide supplemental information explaining why you think you should be considered anyway)

Scholarship Awards

- based on need up to \$5,000
- must be used for educational or training fees, tuition, books, child care, or related travel (some exceptions may apply)
- Participation in the Momentum Leadership Institute Partnership & Project (a 20 hour commitment over a semester)

Requirements

- Most recent official transcript
- A copy of your financial award letter
- A copy of your most recent federal income tax return (along with W-2's or 1099's)
- Proof of enrollment
- Essay answering the following questions:
 1. What challenges do you face today and what personal strengths will help you succeed?
 2. How will this scholarship help you achieve your educational goals?
 3. Once you achieve your educational goal, how do you plan to give back to El Paso?
